

COVID-19 ADVISORY FOR VISITORS TO MWS CENTRES As at 7 July 2022

With the rise in the number of COVID-19 cases in the community, MWS has tightened the Safe Management Measures (SMM) for in-person visits to our Nursing Homes and Welfare Home. This is in line with recommendations from the Ministry of Health.

From **7 July 2022 to 3 August 2022** (both dates inclusive):

- Only 4 pre-designated visitors are allowed per resident;
- Only 1 pre-designated visitor is allowed per visit;
- Each visit will be capped at 30 minutes; and
- Visits may be confined to designated visitor areas outside of wards

Visitors should administer a self-test Antigen Rapid Test (ART) on the day of visit, prior to arriving at the MWS Nursing Homes or Welfare Home.

MWS reserves the right to request for proof of a negative ART result for persons with recent exposure before allowing entry.

MWS also reserves the right to request for additional testing requirements for visitors of unvaccinated residents during this period.

All other SMM remained enforced at the MWS Nursing Homes and Welfare Home, and other MWS Centres.
